Pro Loco Art Competition 2013

Rules of Entry

- Entrants should register their intention to enter between 11th February-17th May 2013 on the Matlock Bath Parish Council website or by contacting the Parish Clerk.
- Entrants must provide their own art materials/paper/canvass.
- Artwork is limited to a maximum of A2 size.
- Artwork can include drawing and painting, graphics, collage, 2D, Textiles etc.
- The finished picture must be based on a scene or artefact from within the Matlock Bath Parish.
- No more than one prize per entrant.
- Maximum of *two* entries from each participant.
- Entrants are responsible for 'dropping off work' for shortlisting no later than 19th May 2013.
- In the event of a dispute, the Chairman's decision is final.
- A short-list of finalists will be drawn up after the closing date.
- The winning work of the Adult first prize will remain with the Parish Council and be part of the permanent display of the winners from previous years.
- All shortlisted work will be displayed on Sunday 26th May 2013 where members of the public will vote for their favourites.
- A presentation ceremony will be held on Monday 27th May 2013.
- Classes of prizes –
 - Adult (aged 17 and over)
 - Junior Artist (Reception-Year 2, Infants)
 - Junior Artist (Years 3-6, Junior)
 - Young Artist (Years 7-11, Secondary)

Value of prizes: 1st Prize £150, 2nd Prize £100, Best Villager £50

Prizes for the Young and Junior Artists will be in the form of gift vouchers.

By entering the competition entrants are giving permission to Matlock Bath Parish Council to use the finished image on any publicity material and/or exhibit as appropriate. ***
